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Australian National Diabetes Audit – Australian Quality Clinical Audit (ANDA-AQCA) 2019

We are now seeking expressions of interest from diabetes centres to participate in ANDA-AQCA 2019. All types of centres from tertiary to primary care may participate.

ANDA-AQCA collects data related to diabetes education, self-care practices and quality of life. Reports are provided which enable participating centres to benchmark their own data against that of others.

This important quality assurance activity promotes continuous improvement in the standard of service provided by diabetes centres and is the primary quality assurance activity of the NADC.

The success of this activity is dependent on a maximum level of participation by centres.

The following is the proposed timetable for the survey in 2019:

Formal invitation to join - March

Distribution of survey forms - April

Data collection on consecutive patients (for 4 weeks) - May or June

Note: The survey can be conducted over 8 weeks (May and June) for centres not able to collect data on more than 30 participants during this period

Centres will be able to provide data using one of the following options:

1. Complete the paper-based data collection form
2. Complete the web-based data collection form (REDCap)
3. Extract data from in-house database

We encourage you to opt for REsearch Data CAPture (REDCap), which was received favourably in the 2018 audit. This is a more time efficient form of data collection ensuring data integrity and reduction in data queries.

The conduct of ANDA will be overseen by Professor Sophia Zoungas (at Monash University/ Monash Health) in consultation with the ANDA Scientific Advisory Committee.

The ANDA Secretariat, Elspeth Lilburn, will act as the 'Trusted Third Party' ensuring centres' de-identified data remains anonymous.

For centres that have participated in past surveys the previous ANDA site number will be used. For new centres wishing to participate a new site number will be allocated.
