Pen needles are designed for single-use only and can result in needle bending¹, needle clogging^{2,3} and lipohypertrophy⁴

What is Lipohypertrophy (Lipo)?

A build-up of fatty lumps that occur when you repeatedly inject your diabetes medication into the same injection site.⁵⁻⁷




These fatty lumps don't absorb your medication in the same way as healthy tissue.⁶

Lipo can lead to increased blood sugar variability and complications.⁶
