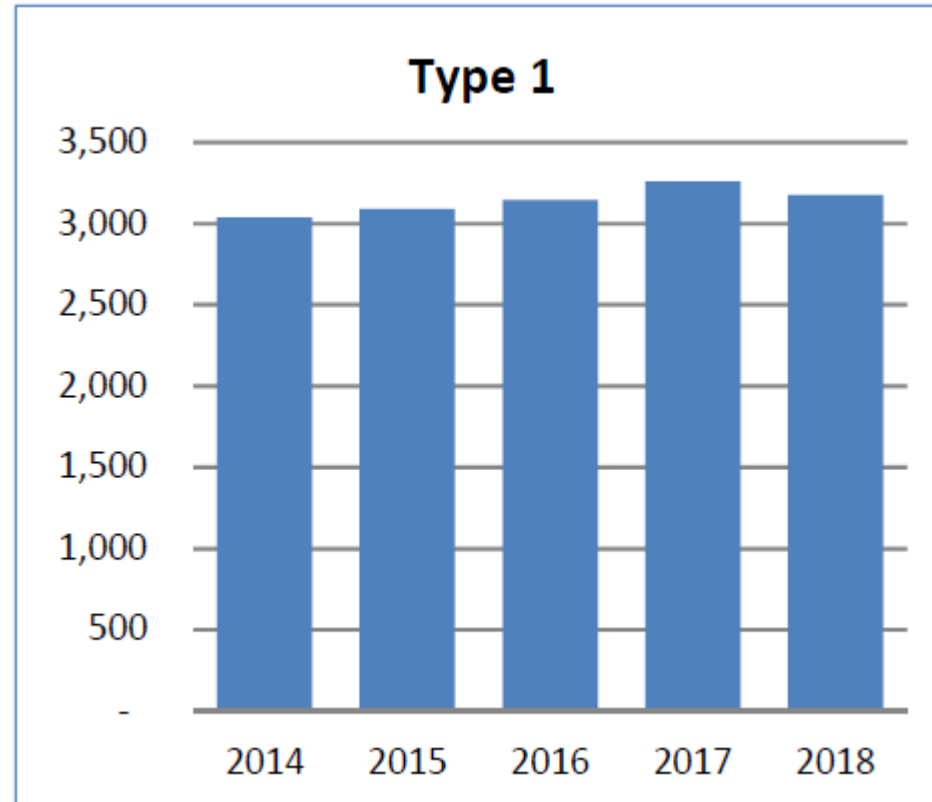
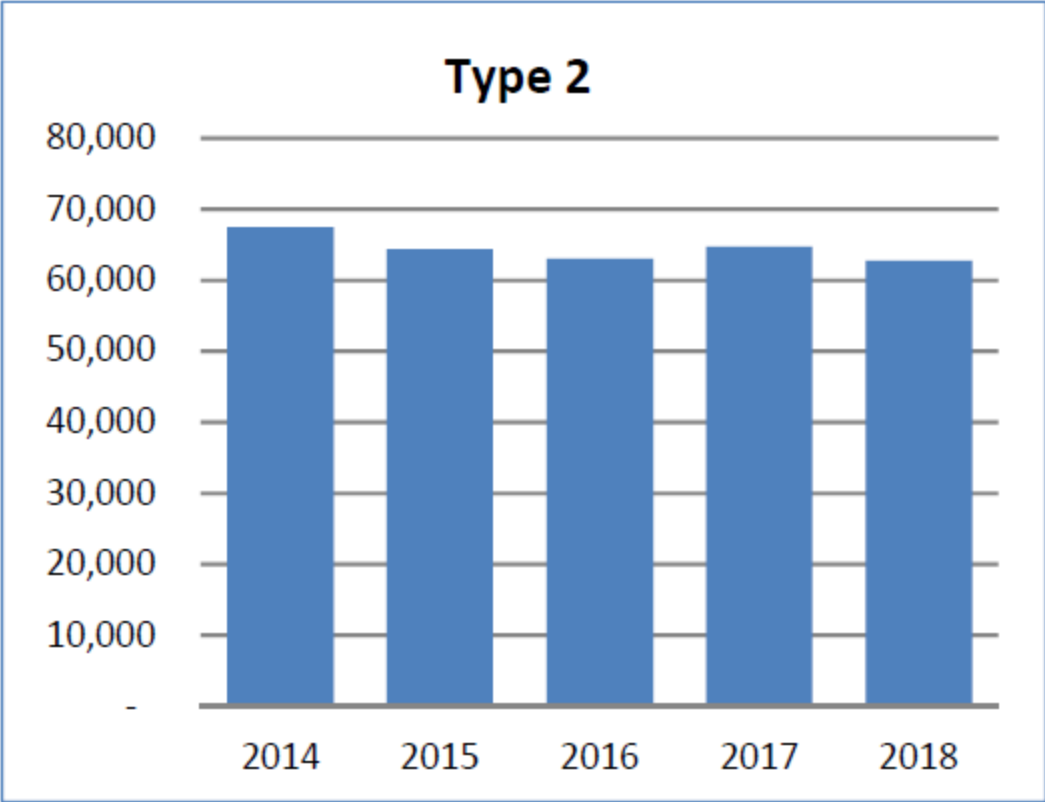

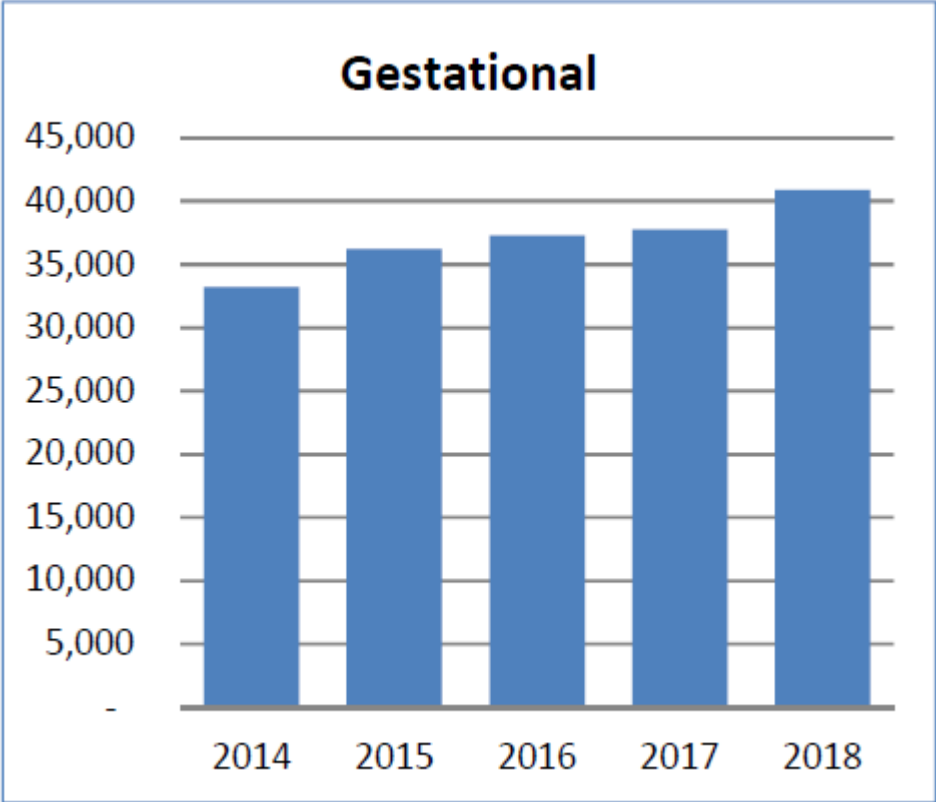
# New Registrants, Year Ending, September 2013 to September 2018

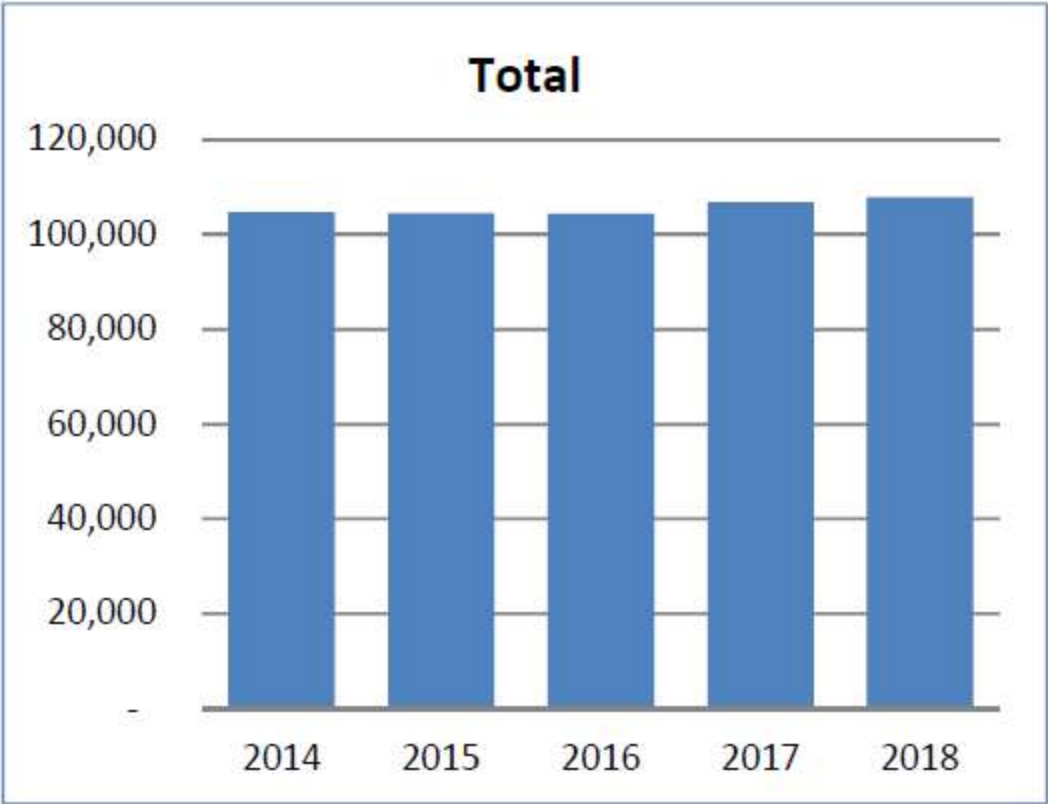

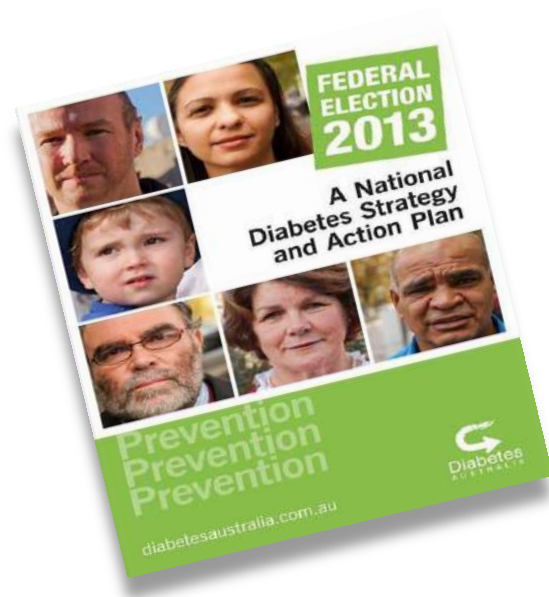

Australian National Diabetes Strategy 2016-2020 released

Federal Budget:

- NDSS changes, threat to funding, pharmacy centric perception
- Supply chain savings
- Biosimilars savings (\$800m)



## 2016

- New NDSS Agreement 2016-2020 \$174m over 4 years
- Qld Govt - diabetes prevention \$27m over 4 years
- Vic Govt - diabetes prevention \$4.5m for one year
- Pharmacy Diabetes Screening \$50m over 4 years

## 2017

- Continuous glucose monitoring \$54m over 4 years
- Vic Gov diabetes prevention \$9.1m over 2 years
- New MBS items retinal photos \$34m over 4 years

## 2018

- Diabetes in Schools \$6.1m over 2 years
- Online type 2 diabetes education \$2m over 2 years
- Future Fund targeted research \$125m over 9 years
- Insulin pump subsidy program \$6.2m over 4 years
- KeepSight diabetes blindness prevention \$1m initial grant\*\*
- Healthy weight for women in pregnancy \$3m over 4 years
- Active older Australians \$22.9m over 4 years
