**Diabetes** 

**4**x

**4 times risk** of heart failure

Eyes

**Main cause** of preventable blindness

2x

2 times risk of heart attack (leading cause of death)

20%

20% more risk of cancer

2x

2 times risk of stroke

1 in 3

1 in 3 develop kidney disease

2x

2 times risk of dementia

2%

2% have amputation

Our Diabetes Hot Spot 12%

**12%** of adults in our community with diabetes

4%

**4%** of people 20-44yrs have diabetes

18%

**18%** of adults attending Emergency Departments or General Practice have diabetes

20%

**20%** of people age 65yrs or above have diabetes

30%

**30%** of adults attending Emergency Departments or General Practice have pre-diabetes

22%

**22%** of adults in Blacktown Hospital have diabetes

1.5-3x

**Twice the risk** for people from Asia, Pacific and First Nations people for diabetes and serious complications

### **Diabetes in western Sydney**

12% of adults in WSLHD community with diabetes

**30%** of adults attending Emergency Departments or General Practice have pre-diabetes


18% of adults attending Emergency Departments or General Practice have diabetes

21 % of adults in Blacktown Hospital have diabetes

Average annual cost of a patient with Type 2 diabetes in western Sydney is \$16,124

**91,500**people with diabetes in WSLHD community

Estimated costs \$1.48 Billion/year





